## August 2025 themed members show details



Abstraction and Macro works evoke emotion and curiosity by representing the world or the unknown through simplified elements—color, shape, emotion, and movement—without relying on clearly defined edges or details. These works often express feelings more effectively than detailed representations, as viewers instinctively fill in the gaps with their own experiences. Macro depictions of the world often feel alien, also evoking discovery and curiosity. Let's fill the walls with creations that capture the imagination.

All Chaparral Artists MEMBERS are invited to submit their work. Not a member? Become one on intake day! Submissions must be created by the artist - originals or prints are acceptable during *members' shows*.

**Specifications:** 5 entries per artist will be accepted\*. Entries not to exceed standard **20"x24"** frames or an *approximate* equivalent 'non-standard' frame. We realize that the outer frame adds several inches on all sides. This is acceptable.

- Entries **MUST** be ready to hang by wire
- Triangle, sawtooth and other methods of hanging are discouraged
- Tape securing work within frames will not be accepted
- Entries must be received **BEFORE** the end of the intake period, or they will not be accepted

***This rule may be adjusted by the Chaparral Show Committee on intake day based on the total number of entries received. For members-only shows with fewer participating artists, you might be able to submit up to 8 entries. In busier shows, we'll prioritize the first come, first hung basis and limit you to your top 5 entries.***

**Preparation:** Every entry needs a tag on the back with the artist's name, phone number, title, and sale price. We provide digital tags on the website if you prefer to fill them out before intake.

**Sales:** 60% of the sales will go to the artist and 40% will go to Rainbow Stew.

**Fees:** No fees for members-only shows. Just ensure you're a paid-up member for the 2025 year.

**Delivery:** Entries shall be delivered to Rainbow Stew (55509 29 Palms Hwy, Yucca Valley) on  
**Thursday, August 14 from 4:30-6 pm**      OR      **Friday, August 15 from 12:30-2 pm**

**Reception:** We align our casual gatherings with the revived Old-Town Art celebration taking place every third Saturday of the month. During our "soft" receptions, our members aim to trickle in at Rainbow Stew between 4 pm and 6 pm, increasing the likelihood of encountering fellow Chaparral members. We encourage participating artists to attend and celebrate their talents as well as other creators!
