All Chaparral Artists MEMBERS are invited to submit their work. Not a member? Become one on intake day!  
Submissions must be created by the artist - originals or prints are acceptable during *members' shows*.

**Specifications:** 5 entries per artist will be accepted\*. Entries not to exceed **20”x24”** frames or an *approximate* equivalent ‘non-standard’ frame. We realize that the outer frame adds several inches on all sides. This is acceptable.

- Entries **MUST** be ready to hang on a hook
- Triangle, sawtooth and other methods of hanging are frowned upon
- Tape securing work within frames is problematic and we do not accept liability if it falls apart
- Entries must be received **BEFORE** the end of the intake period

*This rule may be adjusted by the Chaparral Show Committee on intake day based on the total number of entries received. For members-only shows with fewer participating artists, you might be able to submit more entries! In busier shows, we'll prioritize the first come, first hung basis and limit you to your top 5 entries.*

**Preparation:** Every entry needs a tag on the back with the artist's name, phone number, title, and sale price. We provide digital tags on the website if you prefer to fill them out before intake.

**Sales:** 60% of the sales will go to the artist and 40% will go to Rainbow Stew.

**Fees:** No fees for members-only shows. Just ensure you're a paid-up member for the 2026 year.

**Delivery:** Entries shall be delivered to Rainbow Stew on  
**Thursday, June 11 from 4:30-6 pm** OR **Friday, June 12 from 12:30-2 pm**

**Pickup:** Entries shall be picked up from Rainbow Stew on  
**Thursday, July 16 from 4:30-6 pm** OR **Friday, July 17 from 12:30-2 pm**

**Reception:** We align our gatherings with the revived Old-Town Art celebration taking place every third Saturday of the month. Feel free to drop by and say hello!

**Saturday, June 20 from 4-6 pm**

**Liability:** Chaparral Artists and Rainbow Stew assume no responsibility for loss or damage. Artists may want to secure their own insurance.
